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WHAT IS THE JEREMIAH TREE?

The Jeremiah Tree Ministry

The old-time Gospel still has the power to save, to sanctify, and to make all things new. At The Jeremiah Tree, we believe there is no life so broken that the Great Physician cannot heal it, and no soul so far away that the Good Shepherd cannot bring it home. When a man's life has been shattered by sin, whether through drugs, alcohol, or the consequences of destructive choices, and he reaches the place where he needs a true beginning again, we stand ready with open arms and the hope of Jesus Christ.

The Jeremiah Tree exists as the intensive care arm of the Church, ministering to men whose lives have reached a spiritual crisis. Just as a hospital's intensive care unit provides constant attention to those in the greatest need, our ministry provides a Christ-centered, discipleship-driven environment where men can be restored through the transforming power of the Gospel. Every day is filled with the preaching and teaching of God's Word, heartfelt prayer, biblical mentoring, loving accountability, honest fellowship, meaningful work, and the encouragement of a Christian community that refuses to give up on them. Our purpose is not merely to help men overcome addiction, we seek to see them born again, grounded in the faith, and growing into mature disciples who discover their true identity in Christ and begin to walk in the abundant life He promised.

We believe that true recovery is not found in behavior modification alone, but in heart transformation. When Jesus changes a man's heart, He changes his home, his family, his future, and even generations yet to come. By the grace of God, we have witnessed broken men become faithful fathers, dependable workers, devoted church members, and bold witnesses for Christ. The same Savior who raised Lazarus from the grave is still calling men out of darkness today, and we rejoice every time another life is made new by His marvelous grace.

The Modern-Day Inn

Our ministry is patterned after the Good Samaritan found in Luke chapter 10. When the wounded traveler was left beaten, broken, and unable to help himself, the Good Samaritan did not simply offer a few words of encouragement and continue on his way. He bound up the man's wounds, placed him upon his own beast, and carried him to an inn where he could receive the care he desperately needed. Before leaving, the Samaritan entrusted the wounded man to the innkeeper, saying, "Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee."

We believe The Jeremiah Tree is that modern-day inn. The Church is still called to seek the wounded, but there are times when men need more than a Sunday morning service, they need intensive, daily care as they heal from years of sin, addiction, and brokenness. We gladly serve as that place of refuge where the wounded can rest, recover, and be disciplined until they are strong enough to return to their families, their churches, and their communities. Every meal served, every Bible study taught, every prayer offered, every act of accountability, and every day of discipleship is another bandage placed upon a wounded soul. We simply care for the broken until the Lord finishes the work He has begun, believing with all our hearts that Jesus Christ still restores lives, and the Church is still called to help carry the wounded to the Inn.

Doer of the Word

Rev. Kenny Garrett has served as the Executive Director of The Jeremiah Tree since the summer of 2022. Since answering God's call to this ministry, he has worked faithfully to strengthen and improve the discipleship experience at both the HomePlace and GreenHouse properties, helping create an environment where men can grow spiritually while overcoming addiction and life-controlling struggles. During his time at The Jeremiah Tree, nearly 80 men have come through its doors, with the vast majority finding abundant life in Christ through biblical discipleship, accountability, and the transforming power of the Gospel. In addition to his work at The Jeremiah Tree, Brother Kenny serves as the Pastor of the General Baptist House of Prayer in Fairborn, Ohio, where he is committed to preaching the old-time Gospel and shepherding God's people.

Brother Kenny's testimony is one of God's redeeming grace. Raised in a small General Baptist church, he walked away from his faith around the age of eighteen or nineteen and spent several years living what the King James Version describes as "riotous living." Those years took him far from the Lord, but God never stopped pursuing him. Around the age of twenty-eight, Brother Kenny surrendered his life back to Christ, and it was through that restoration that he experienced God's life-changing mercy firsthand. Not long afterward, the Lord called him into the ministry, giving him a passion for reaching those who have lost hope and pointing them toward the same Savior who changed his own life.

Today, Brother Kenny lives in Riverside, Ohio, with his constant companion, Butterbean the Baptist Bulldog, who has become something of a mascot and friend to many at The Jeremiah Tree. Outside of ministry, he faithfully looks after his mother and treasures every opportunity to spend time with his son, Trysten and his two nieces. Whether he is preaching from the pulpit, mentoring men in recovery, or simply sharing life with family and friends, Brother Kenny's desire remains the same: to see lives transformed by the saving grace of Jesus Christ and to help others discover the abundant life that can only be found in Him.

EVERY MAN'S STORY IS UNIQUE

Men who come to The Jeremiah Tree may share common experiences, struggles, and traits born from the brokenness of sin. Yet no two men arrive the same. Each man carries a story that is completely unique to him, shaped by his own choices, wounds, and the specific circumstances God has allowed. That is why we meet every man exactly where he is.

SHARED EXPERIENCES OF BROKENNESS

Most of the men who come through our doors are carrying the same heavy burdens: addiction, broken relationships, a lost sense of purpose, and, above all, a life separated from God. Though every man's story is different, the root problem is the same: sin has left its mark. That shared experience creates an environment where men can speak honestly, encourage one another, and truly understand what the other is facing. Together, they discover they are not fighting this battle alone.

THE INDIVIDUALITY OF EACH MAN'S CONDITION

While many of the struggles our men face are similar, no two stories are ever the same. Every man comes to us with his own past, his own hurts, his own family, his own failures, and his own God-given strengths. The Lord has a unique plan for every life, and because of that, we refuse to treat men like they are all the same. Taking the time to understand each man's story is an important part of helping him find true healing, restoration, and abundant life in Christ.

MEETING EACH MAN WHERE HE IS

Because every man's journey is different, The Jeremiah Tree is not built around a one-size-fits-all program. Through personal discipleship, daily mentoring, and the leading of the Holy Spirit, we take the time to know each man, understand where he is, and help him grow in the way God intends. Real transformation is personal, and we believe the best way to see lasting change is to walk faithfully beside each man as the Lord does His work.

A PERSONAL PATH TOWARD RESTORATION

God knows every man by name, and He has a purpose and a plan for his life. Our job at The Jeremiah Tree is to walk beside each man as the Lord begins that work of restoration. Through Christ-centered discipleship, prayer, accountability, and genuine relationships, we help each man grow in his faith and discover the abundant life, lasting freedom, and true victory that can only be found in Jesus Christ.

THREE PHASES OF GROWTH

Men move through The Jeremiah Tree program in two distinct stages, each designed to meet them where they are and guide them toward lasting transformation in Christ. The typical stay at the Jeremiah Tree is about one year.

PHASE 1: REST, HEALING & SEEKING GOD

When a man first enters The Jeremiah Tree, he enters a season of rest, healing, and total accountability. Under close supervision and within a safe, structured environment, residents learn to surrender their old ways and begin trusting God with every area of their lives.

This phase emphasizes spiritual foundation-building through daily Scripture, prayer, mentoring, and honest fellowship. Men are given the time and space to heal while learning the disciplines of a Christ-centered life.

PHASE 2: FREEDOM WITHIN STRUCTURE

As men demonstrate growth and faithfulness, they transition into Phase 2, where they are given greater freedom while still living within The Jeremiah Tree structure and community.

In this phase, residents begin seeking gainful employment and learning to conduct their daily lives with responsibility, discipline, and purpose. They practice applying biblical principles to real-world decisions, preparing to walk independently in the victory and abundant life found in Christ.

PHASE 3: THE LOCAL CHURCH

No two men leave the Jeremiah Tree with the exact same plan, because no two men have walked the exact same road. Each man's aftercare is prayerfully developed to fit his individual needs, but one principle never changes: we believe it is both biblical and necessary for every man to be firmly rooted in a faithful local church. The local church is God's design for ongoing discipleship, accountability, fellowship, and spiritual growth, and it is there that each man is encouraged to continue growing in his walk with Christ.

Brother Kenny has also been intentional about naming our country property in New Jasper, The HomePlace. That name reflects far more than a physical location, it describes the heart of our ministry. While many of our men are blessed with loving families to return to, others have never truly known a place they could call home. In the South, the term HomePlace speaks of the place where life begins and where love lives. It is the place you return to for the holidays, the place where you are welcomed without condition, and the place you run when the storms of life come. That is the kind of ministry we desire to provide. Even after a man completes the program, The HomePlace will always remain a place where he can return for encouragement, prayer, godly counsel, and the love of a Christian family as he continues walking in the abundant life Christ has given him.

THE HOMEPLACE - PHASE 1



A PLACE OF RESTORATION & NEW BEGINNINGS

The HomePlace is the heart of The Jeremiah Tree ministry and serves as the Inn from our Lord's parable of the Good Samaritan. Just as the wounded traveler was carried to the inn to be cared for until he could walk again, broken men come to the HomePlace seeking healing from the wounds of addiction, sin, and hopelessness. Here, they find more than a roof over their heads, they find a place where the love of Christ is lived out daily and where the Gospel is faithfully proclaimed.

Nestled in the peaceful countryside at 1726 Paintersville New Jasper Road in Xenia, Ohio, the HomePlace is where old lives are surrendered and new lives begin. Men are welcomed into a family of believers who are committed to helping them grow in the grace and knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ. Every day is centered around the Word of God, prayer, Christian fellowship, honest accountability, meaningful work, and biblical discipleship. We believe lasting freedom is not found merely by putting away drugs or alcohol, but by becoming a new creature in Christ and learning to walk in the abundant life that only He can give.

Under the leadership of HomePlace Manager Tony Cordell, the HomePlace is more than a recovery house, it is a place where men are called to repentance, encouraged in the faith, and discipled to become faithful followers of Jesus Christ. Our desire is not simply to see men get sober, but to see them saved, grounded in God's Word, serving in the local church, and equipped to stand firm in the faith. We believe that when Christ changes a man's heart, He changes his home, his family, and his future. The HomePlace exists to be that welcoming Inn until each man is ready to continue his journey, walking in the victory and abundant life that are found in Christ alone.

COVENANT AGREEMENT

WHAT MAKES US DIFFERENT FROM ALL OTHER RECOVERY PROGRAMS

OUR COMMITMENT TO ONE ANOTHER

The Jeremiah Tree Covenant Agreement is far more than a list of rules, it is a covenant of discipleship between the Jeremiah Tree and every man who enters our care. We recognize that no two men arrive with the same story, the same struggles, or the same God-given gifts. For that reason, Brother Kenny spends the first week getting to know each resident personally before prayerfully developing a written plan tailored to that man's unique strengths, weaknesses, and spiritual needs. Rather than offering a one-size-fits-all program, we seek God's wisdom in guiding each man toward the abundant life found in Jesus Christ.

This covenant serves as a roadmap for that journey. It calls every resident to daily devotion, prayer, and spiritual growth; accountability to staff, mentors, and fellow brothers in Christ; a life free from drugs and alcohol; faithful participation in Bible studies, work assignments, and ministry activities; respect for others and the property God has entrusted to us; and a commitment to honesty, integrity, and genuine repentance. These expectations are not burdens to bear but biblical principles that help a man put off the old life and walk in the newness of life that Christ provides.

When a man signs the Jeremiah Tree Covenant Agreement, he is making more than a promise to a ministry, he is committing himself to a journey of faith. In return, The Jeremiah Tree pledges to stand beside him with biblical truth, loving accountability, Christian fellowship, and the unwavering hope of the Gospel. Together, we believe that what God begins through a surrendered heart, He is faithful to complete, bringing broken men into the abundant life that is found in Christ alone.

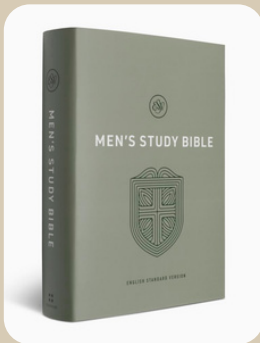

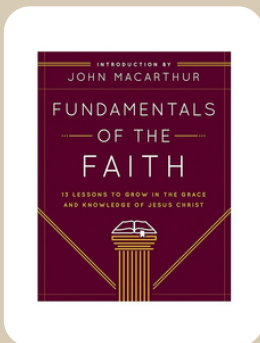
BUILDING FAITH, FREEDOM & FOUNDATION

At The Jeremiah Tree, we use these three core resources to guide men through spiritual growth, biblical understanding, and recovery from addiction.



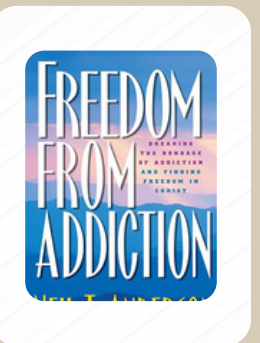
CROSSWAYS ESV MEN'S STUDY BIBLE

The Crossway ESV Men's Study Bible is one of the primary discipleship tools used at The Jeremiah Tree. We believe lasting freedom is found not in man's wisdom, but in the life-changing power of God's Word. This study Bible helps men grow in their understanding of Scripture, strengthen their faith, and build their lives upon the solid foundation of Jesus Christ. As they study God's Word each day, they are encouraged to leave the old life behind and walk in the abundant life found in Christ.



FUNDAMENTALS OF THE FAITH

Fundamentals of the Faith is one of the foundational discipleship studies used at The Jeremiah Tree to ground men in the unchanging truths of God's Word. From salvation and the person of Jesus Christ to prayer, the church, and Christian living, this study helps men become rooted in the essential doctrines of the faith. We believe a strong Christian life begins with a firm biblical foundation, equipping every man to stand faithfully, serve the Lord, and walk daily in the victory found in Jesus Christ.



FREEDOM FROM ADDICTION

Freedom from Addiction reminds men that lasting victory is not found in programs or willpower, but in the saving and transforming power of Jesus Christ. Built upon the truth of God's Word, this study teaches that freedom begins when a man understands who he is in Christ and learns to walk in the new life God has given him. At The Jeremiah Tree, we believe Christ not only breaks the chains of addiction but also restores broken lives for His glory.

HEALING

Living the abundant life begins at the foot of the Cross, where broken hearts are healed, sins are forgiven, and old lives are made new through Jesus Christ. No matter how deep the wounds of the past, there is hope, restoration, and a new beginning for every soul that comes to Him in faith.

Through continued accountability, Christian fellowship, and practical responsibility, residents learn that the abundant life is not simply about maintaining sobriety, it is about becoming mature disciples of Jesus Christ who are equipped to serve their families, their churches, and their communities for the glory of God.

The Lord has blessed us with a beautiful piece of ground at the Jeremiah Tree's HomePlace, and we believe He has greater things yet in store. Nearby, a playground will be built so the children of the men in our program can laugh, play, and spend precious time with their fathers. Addiction has stolen enough from these families. We believe the Lord is able to restore what the locust has eaten, and Victory Grove will provide a peaceful place where those broken relationships can begin to heal.

Flowing beside the property is a beautiful creek where we are preparing a baptism area. We look forward to seeing men publicly declare their new life in Christ as they step into those waters, leaving the old life behind and rising to walk in newness of life. We are also creating a picnic area where churches, supporters, volunteers, and families can gather together in Christian fellowship. Victory Grove is more than a project, it is a testimony that Jesus Christ is still saving souls, changing lives, restoring homes, and giving abundant life to all who come unto Him. By God's grace, this little grove will become a place where victories are celebrated, prayers are answered, and generations will see the faithfulness of the Lord.

HOPE & HELP FOR ADDICTION

If you or someone you love is struggling with addiction to alcohol or drugs, please know that help is available and you are not alone. Healing begins with honest next steps and the courage to reach out. The Jeremiah Tree exists to walk alongside men in this journey toward freedom and restoration through Jesus Christ.

1. ADMIT THE NEED FOR HELP

The first step toward freedom is being honest about where you are. Addiction thrives in secrecy, excuses, and denial, but healing begins when the struggle is brought into the light. If alcohol or drugs have taken hold of your life, or the life of someone you love, don't ignore it any longer. Face it with courage, tell the truth about it, and take the first step toward the abundant life Christ offers.

2. REACH OUT RIGHT AWAY

Reach out to someone you trust, a pastor, a faithful family member, the Jeremiah Tree, or another godly friend. God never intended for us to fight our battles alone. One phone call, one conversation, or one step of faith can be the beginning of a life completely transformed by the grace of Jesus Christ. 3. SEEK TREATMENT & ACCOUNTABILITY

Take the next step and commit yourself to the process. Recovery is not found in a quick fix but through faithful discipleship, daily accountability, wise counsel, and, when needed, proper medical care. At The Jeremiah Tree, men are surrounded by a Christ-centered community where they are taught God's Word, mentored by faithful believers, and encouraged every day as they walk the road from addiction to the abundant life found in Jesus Christ.

4. FOR LOVED ONES

Love them enough to tell them the truth, and love them enough not to help them stay in their sin. Set godly boundaries, pray for them faithfully, and never lose hope that Christ can change their life. You cannot make someone choose recovery, but you can point them to Jesus, encourage them to seek help, and refuse to enable the very things that are destroying them. Sometimes the most loving thing you can do is stand firm while trusting God to do the work that only He can do.
